Uniform Guidance Procurement Standards Open Forum



Over 100 people attended the open forum hosted by Procurement Services and the Office of Research on Friday, June 22 to learn more about the Procurement Standards for Uniform Guidance that went into

effect on July 1st. Uniform Guidance (UG) is a set of federal regulations that impacts research administration and significantly reforms federal grants to focus resources on improving performance and outcomes. It is an important compliance requirement to follow the Uniform Guidance Procurement Standards when procuring goods and services using any amount of a federal fund.

The purpose for the Uniform Guidance is to reduce administrative burden for grant applicants and recipients, as well as to reduce the risk of waste, fraud, and abuse. The new Procurement Standards for UG concentrates on increased competition and transparency in the purchasing process when using federal funds.

NEW HIPAA AND FERPA-COMPLIANT DOCUMENT SCANNING SUPPLIER – SPECTRUM INFORMATION SERVICES

- 2. If the quote is acceptable, create a KFS Requisition (vendor # 26745-0) and process through your departmental workflow.
- 3. Review, sign, and forward statement of work to contracts@uci.edu.
