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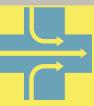

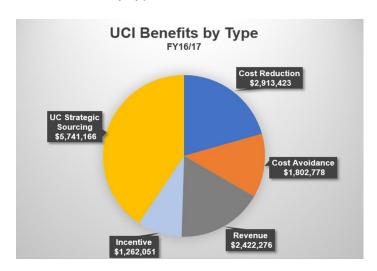

PCDO Reconciliation

As a reminder, as of Monday, July 17th, cardholders are no longer required to complete an internal requisition form and get pre-approval before making a PALCard purchase. An **Image Scanning** tab now appears in the PCDO

document for PALCard-holders to upload backup documentation (receipts, packing slips, etc.). With this change, KFS will now be the Office of Record for PALCard transactions. It is recommended for business managers and department heads/deans to discuss their business processes before implementing this change.

UCIMC—Now Using KFS For Asset Management

The Procurement Services Equipment
Management Office is now supporting asset
management, new asset property ID tags and
surplus property management at UC Irvine
Medical Center. This program streamlines
administrative processes, and supports the four
pillars of UCl's Strategic Plan. The KFS System
Capital Asset Management will now replace their
manual paper-based system for managing assets
and surplus property.

In order to save Medical Center space, retired property will now be sent from the Medical Center to our UCI Campus Surplus Property warehouse. The property will be reused or recycled to further help UCI meet its sustainability goals.

This program is expected to improve efficiencies and save UC Irvine Health over \$500,000 in the next two years.
